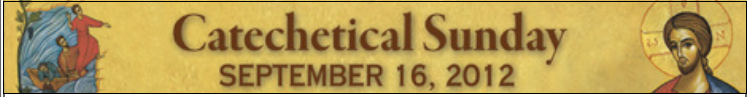

So summer time draws to a close, as this past week we celebrated Labor Day and the re-opening of school. Our thoughts quickly turn to our Faith Formation Program and a “Year of Faith,” as we begin this catechetical year.

All who exercise a catechetical ministry will be installed and blessed on Catechetical Sunday, September 16th at the 10am Liturgy. This includes catechists, RCIA and RCIC, and those who work in adult faith formation. Support staff are also included.

You are reminded that classes begin September 23rd. At this point we truly are lagging in our registration. We have sixty-one registered students as compared to approximately one hundred and thirty last year. We have had a number of registration opportunities. There is information available in the back of the church, including the yearly calendar and registration forms if you are in need of them. A table is available at the church entrance today after all the Masses for those who would like to register. I am available for any questions you might have.

On September 23 all students K-10, plus one parent, will be meeting in the church after the 10am liturgy for the opening announcements for the year etc. We have all our catechists but are still in need of support in the area of teacher assistants.

Please note that this year, in addition to the registration fee (\$40, \$70, \$100) depending on the number of children, you will be asked to buy the textbooks for the children so that each child is able to have his/her own text. It makes more sense and provides the opportunity for sound learning.

It is a joy for me to be back with you and to continue our journey together.

As we renew our faith this year and celebrate our Catholic heritage, may we always remember there is one faith, one Lord, one Baptism!
