FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTORAL ASSOCIATE FOR ADMINISTRATION: We have had several complaints 5 regarding the Air Conditioning in the Church and how loud it is and how insufficient the units are working. I had two estimates prepared one for central air which consists of (4) units that are (15 seer) the estimate is \$22,800. The second estimate that I received was for (4) units that are (8.5 seer) which are less efficient and loud for an estimate of \$14,210. We have been offered monies toward the above expense but unfortunately the estimates are higher than anticipated and not in our current budget. I would appreciate any financial input or information that you may have in this regard.

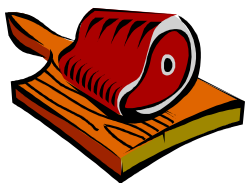
