My Dear Parishioners:

This past weekend we had a visiting priest, one that I understand is quite familiar with Ravena. It was Father James O'Neill, who is a retired priest of the Albany Diocese and a hometown boy. Many times we hear things that we feel in our hearts but have yet to find the words for them. Father O'Neill's sermon did for me exactly as hoped.

When he said that the beautiful feasts of the Christmas season had been celebrated and the manger scene had come down to be stored for yet another year, the question seemed somewhat rhetorical. What could possibly top all of that? He quickly reminded us that the people who walked in darkness had seen a great light. The theme of light occurs repeatedly not only through the Christmas season but through the entire church year. So we are called to be bearers of the light; witnesses to Christ the Light of the World. Hopefully, we can bring Christ to others as we experience the light in Him each and every day of our lives.

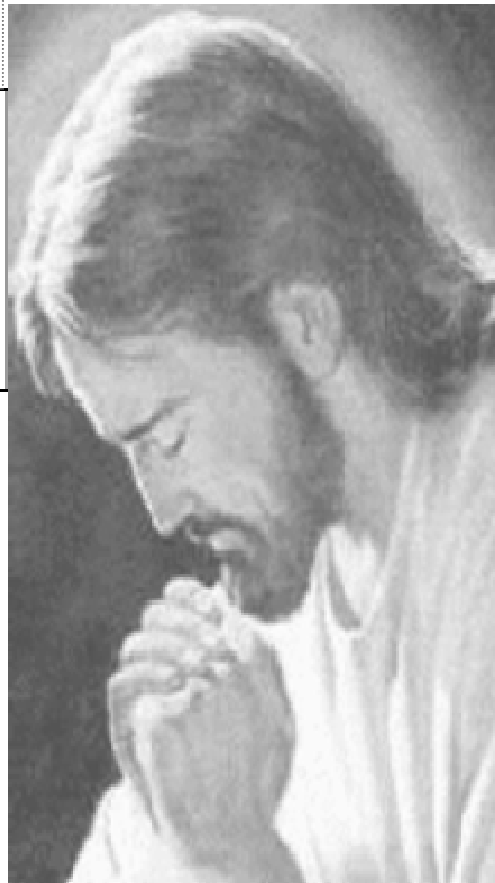
