KATERI CANONIZATION PILGRIMAGE: Oct. 16-23. Join Bishop Hubbard and fellow parishioners from around the Diocese on a pilgrimage to ITALY to participate in the CANONIZATION of OUR VERY OWN HOMETOWN SAINT KATERI TEKAKWITHA. Highlights of the tour include over-nights in Assisi where St. Francis lived and Rome as well as day trips outside of the Eternal City. The Canonization will take place on Sunday, Oct 21, where we will be present in St. Peter’s Square when our Holy Father raises KATERI to SAINT. Cost per person is \$2,895 which includes: Participation in the canonization, motor coach transfer from Albany to JFK and back, roundtrip air fair from JFK/EWR airport in Rome, airport taxes & surcharges, deluxe motor coach in Italy, hotels 3&4 star-6 nights, breakfast & dinner daily, tour escort & guides, hotel service charges & gratuities, sight-seeing & admission fees as per itinerary.

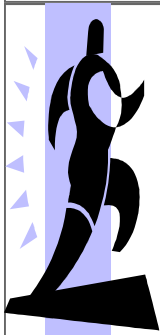
