The registration process for the 2013-14 catechetical year, will soon begin. The United States Catholic Conference of Bishops has selected the theme, "Open the Door of Faith" for the catechetical year officially beginning on September 15th. Our parish program begins that day at the 10 am Mass asking the Holy Spirit for guidance and direction. There will be a brief gathering of all in the parish center to meet the catechists for each grade. Classes will officially start September 22nd, following the 10 am Liturgy.

This year there are three goals that are very important to the success of our program. These include: (1) increased parental participation, (2) improved Mass attendance, (3) and implementing the use of technology for instructional purposes. An internet connection is being provided in the parish center to allow this to happen. It has been made possible by our benefactors. We are most grateful.

A reminder to the men in the parish, I will initiate a men's group providing learning activities and spiritual discernment. All are welcome! The Women's Bible study group continues and will be shared by Fr. Jim Kane, Linda Bruno and me. It should be a very enriching and spiritual journey.

The forms and calendar for Faith Formation will be available on line and in the back of the church beginning August 4th. Please be certain to accurately fill out and supply all required information. Also, remember that registration for our program includes weekly attendance at the Divine Liturgy, hopefully as a family. There will be occasions when all Faith Formation students will be asked to attend and participate in the Liturgy. Liturgy is the center of our lives as Catholics because of our celebration of the Eucharist.

We also have a very active RCIA and RCIC program. Those wishing to join the church who have missed the conventional benchmarks, please do not hesitate to contact me.

Should you wish to join in any of these programs you are welcomed. Catechists and teacher assistants are always needed for Faith Formation and we would gladly welcome you.


