**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:**

Some have asked: "Why didn't we just choose a Sunday morning Mass for the Summer in between 8 & 10 (Viz., 9 A.M.)? The diocesan pastoral planning process, "Called to BE Church," recommended and the diocese approved a Mass schedule for the future (E.g., when there is one priest for Cossackie & Ravena) that would alternate the 4 P.M. Saturday between here & St. Mary's and St. Patrick's Sunday morning Mass would be at 9:30.

In anticipation of that, it seems prudent to get used to that time. In this context, let me remind us, despite any rumors circulating, that the future status of our two parishes remains for discussion both by the 2 parishes & the diocese. All that has been determined to date is that when one of the priests leaves/retires he will not be replaced; i.e., there will be one priest for the 2 parishes; status of parishes, worship sites, Etc. are all to be determined.

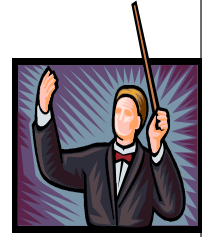
