FROM THE PASTOR’S DESK:

It is an ancient custom to have Masses offered for the eternal peace of deceased loved ones. The 2014 Mass Intentions Book will open on Monday, November 4th.

Requested dates for Masses will be given on a “first-come, first-served” basis, as close to the day as possible. It is always understood that dates cannot be guaranteed: the priest’s vacation, retreat, Etc. cannot be planned a year in advance. A Funeral will supplant the usual 9 A.M. Mass (and the intention moved to the nearest available time). Except for the homebound, Mass intentions must be requested in person at the Rectory Office. The usual stipend offering is \$10; it is part of the priest’s support. By canon law, the pastor must celebrate a Mass for the parishioners every Sunday & holy day. This leaves only 2 weekend intentions and 4 weekday intentions. So, unless otherwise, requested, we may need to double the intentions for each Mass (the extra stipend is sent to the Society for the Propagation of the Faith, for needy priests). To be fair to all, it may be necessary to limit intentions per individual and per family, especially for the popular weekend Masses, Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.
