My Dear Parishioners,

This is the day the Lord has made! Yes, we rejoice that Christ has conquered sin and death and we are heirs to that wonderful legacy! Holy Week is past but we are indeed an Easter people.

You are reminded that Faith Formation concludes on Sunday, April 29th. That will be our registration day for the 2012-13 catechetical year. One parent is asked to attend class that day with your child to complete the registration process. All the necessary forms will be given to you by your child’s catechist. It is important that all cooperate in this process. It is much easier to know what to plan for over the summer. Also, this coming school year we will return to each student having his/her own textbook. That is certainly much more conducive to learning. Registration fees are \$40 per child or \$70 for two. There will also be a book fee payable at the beginning of the 2012-13 school year. Parents please consider serving in our Faith Formation program, either as a catechist or teacher assistant. We always need catechists, aides and substitutes.

Very soon we will see our second graders making their First Holy Communion at the various Masses. Also our Confirmation candidates will be confirmed on May 9th, 7 P.M. at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, the mother church of our diocese. They will rehearse for this on Sunday, May 6th, following the 10 AM Mass, here in the church. Our Confirmation class will complete their requirements after their interviews on April 22nd and their participation in the annual Crop Walk. 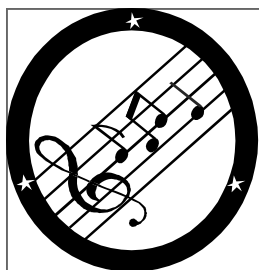

2012 Spring Enrichment-The Heart of Christ

Keynote speaker to kick off the 2012 Spring Enrichment will be Rev. James Martin. Spring Enrichment is an annual four-day series of talks and workshops for catechists, young ministers, liturgical ministers and others in the parish ministries. It is sponsored by the Albany diocesan Office of Evangelization, Catechesis and Family Life. Spring Enrichment will be held from May 14-17 at the College of Saint Rose in Albany. The cost of registration is \$12 per session, maximum of \$108 per person for 9 or more courses. If registration is received before April 27th it is \$10 per session, maximum of \$90 for 9 or more courses.
