### Faith Formation Ministry

My Dear Parishioners:

Gaudete Sunday, which is the third Sunday of Advent is a time for rejoicing-Rejoicing that our salvation is at hand! It is distinguished on the advent wreath by the rose colored candle. We hear from the reading of Isaiah: "Be strong, fear not! Here is your God, he comes with vindication, with divine recompense, he comes to save you."

In the gospel we find John the Baptist in prison. He sent his disciples to Jesus with this question, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Jesus said, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. It is clear that the one John spoke to so often had come. He was among the people curing their ills. Yes, salvation had come!

The last two Sundays of Advent truly focus on the Christmas and the coming of the messiah and Savior. Are we ready to give him a home in our hearts as he comes in the form of a tiny infant surrounded by animals and all of the odors that come with husbandry? Yet we hear "Lo How a rose ere blooming from tender reed has sprung. Was Jesse lineage coming..." Be happy because soon we will hear "Rejoice, again I say rejoice!

There are some ornaments on our Jesse tree, near the Tabernacle, made by our Faith Formation students. Please feel free to look at them after Mass.
