**LENTEN BIBLE STUDY:**

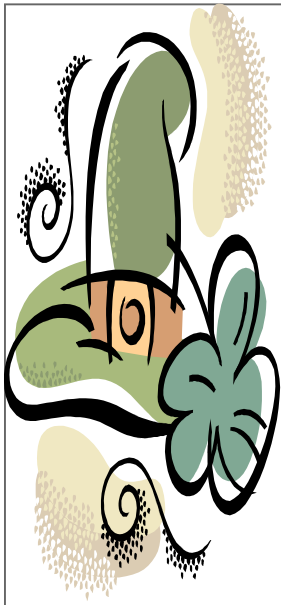

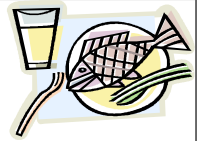
