For the remainder of the Summer, the parish offices will not be opened on Fridays. The offices will reopen on Friday’s beginning 9/7. *Lori Nunziato*

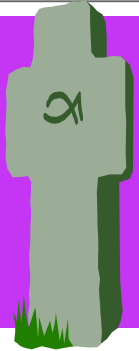
