My Dear Parishioners,
One thing that we can always be certain of in our lives, is change. From the moment of our conception until our death, change appears to be the rule. Explore the life cycle and it is clear that we move changing from one phase to the other throughout our lives. We are even reminded in our faith, that at death our lives do not end but are changed.

There are other types of changes that also influence the way we live. Are we changed because we are Roman Catholics and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ? Are we changed because we attend Mass and are privileged to share in the redemptive experience all over again? Are we changed when we come into contact with our families, with our faith community, and friends? Do we remain open to the changes that these relationships can bring? Finally, do we allow the Holy Spirit to work in our lives allowing the changes God wants for us? The Holy Spirit is ever present bringing us the grace to sustain these changes.

Being the “Year of Faith,” we should take the opportunity and examine how our Church has changed yet remained the same in so many ways. Have we allowed the changes made during Vatican II to renew our faith and make us active participants in the church? There was a song written after Vatican II which carries the message on how to deal with change. It says, “ Grant to us O Lord a heart renewed; recreate in us your own spirit Lord!” Once again, an appeal is made for additional catechists and teacher assistants for next year’s Faith Formation program. The goal is to have two per grade so that no one is locked into every Sunday. Assistance is needed in the area of Youth Ministry. We could really use someone who could devote the time, effort, and energy to working with our young adults. That component needs to be addressed. As we have a Women’s Bible study group, I would like to begin a Men’s group as well, and perhaps we could come together from time to time. Sign up for the men’s group will be in early fall. Wouldn’t you consider some of these things as they are opportunities for positive change? Be an agent of change and influence the lives of others.

Let us pray for each other as we meet the challenges of the change in our lives during the summer months. God Bless you!

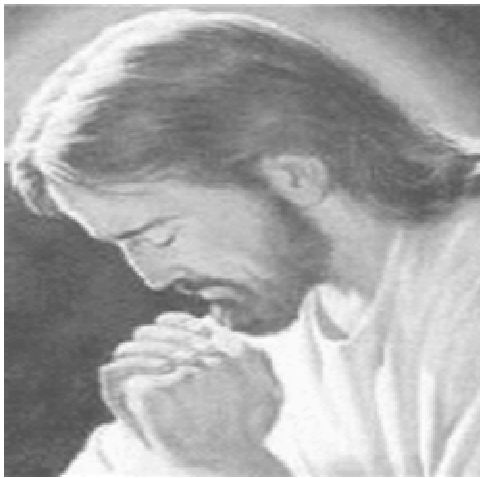
