My Dear Parishioners:

We meet remarkable people every day! When we listen to their life journey, we understand what makes them so special. They have the courage to take a risk and to respond to an inner call; the call to follow the Lord with your whole heart.

We are each called to do this in so many ways. As I listened to Rick Lesser describe his journey to study for the priesthood last week, it is true that God does write on crooked lines and he calls when we least expect. We do not have God figured out nor could we ever contain him in such a small space. Let us commit to pray for Rick as the next two years bring him closer to God’s plan for him. We have turned the corner on the summer and realize that we now hear everyday about something to do with back to school and beginning to think about our fall schedules. You are reminded that we hope to have a wonderful faith formation program this fall, including spiritual nourishment both in our Men’s Group conducted by me and in our Women’s Bible Group conducted by me, Father Jim Kane and Linda Bruno. Welcome Linda, we are so happy to have you here with us!

Faith Formation opening Mass is Sunday, Sept. 15th at 10 am Liturgy. All are expected to attend with at least one parent. Please sit by grade. Signs will be posted. The theme for the homily that day will be the catechetical theme of “opening the door of faith.”

Faith Formation classes begin for all grades K-10 on Sept. 22nd. At least one parent should also be present for that first class so you have the opportunity to meet the catechist and hear about the program to be studied. Parents are reminded that you are our greatest resource and the first teacher of your children.

There are registration forms in the back of the church and feel free to take them. If there is more than one child there is room on the form; so one form per family. The fee is unchanged. It is \$40/ student. For two students it is \$75. For more than two it is \$100. The retreat fee for the First Communion class is \$25, paid at the time of the retreat. The Confirmation retreat has a fee of \$50. Registration forms may be mailed in, placed in the basket, or sent via email.

As always, we look for continued assistance in our program. We could use additional catechists, teacher assistants, and others.
