My Dear Parishioners:

Catechetical Sunday is celebrated throughout the world as a significant Sunday in the lives of those who strive to know the faith and those who impart it. Each of you is called to be a catechist whether by thought, word or action. Faith Formation is at the very heart of parish life and central to the vitality of the Faith Community and its experiences. Catecheses (that which is taught) is imparted to the parish in a variety of ways. It happens through liturgical and para liturgical celebrations, through direct or assisted instruction in the classroom, through the use of technology, through parental interaction with children at home, and through Sunday and daily Mass attendance. The Eucharist is central to all that we do. The real presence is that which separates us from many other denominations. Let us remember those who also work with our adults in the study of sacred scripture. Your are reminded there is a new Men's group being formed and certainly encouraged to attend and join in cultivating stepping stones to the door of faith.
